

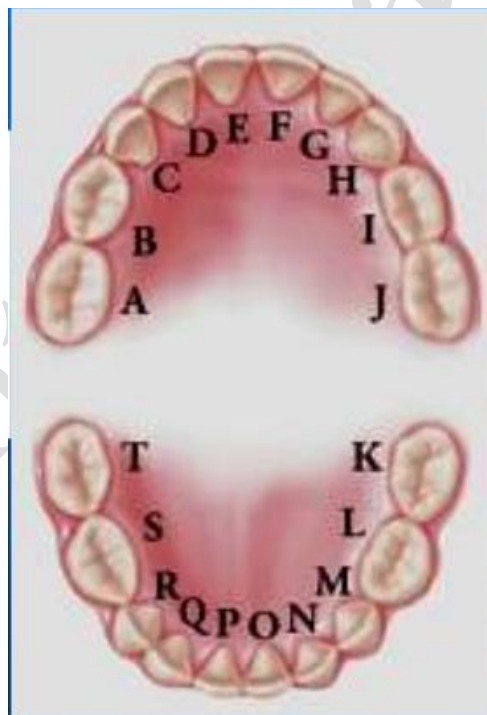
b) *Deciduous teeth:*

For the maxillary teeth, beginning with the right second molar, letters A through J, and for the mandibular teeth, letters K through T, beginning with the left mandibular second molar.

#O: Deciduous mandibular left central incisor.



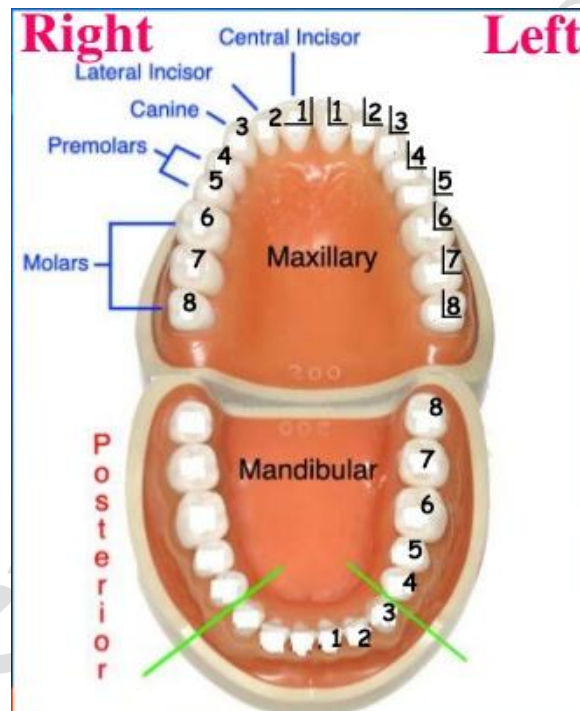

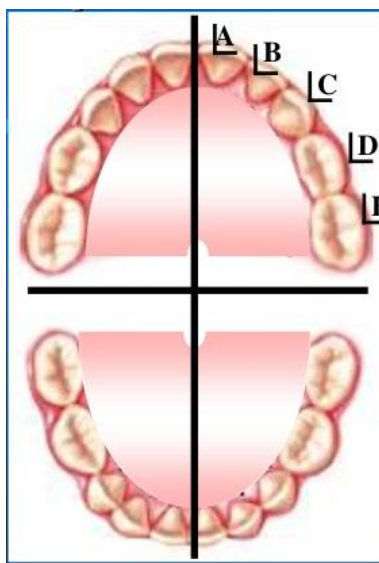

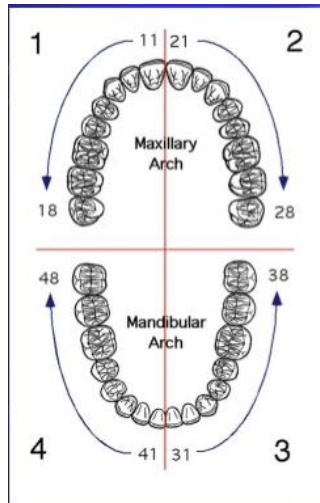

Numeral 1 indicates the maxillary right quadrant, and 2 indicates the maxillary left quadrant, number 3 indicates the mandibular left quadrant. The number 4 indicates the mandibular right quadrant, and the second number of the two-digit number is the tooth number for each side as numbered by palmer notation system.

Thus, as in the two-digit FDI system for the permanent dentition, the first digit indicates the quadrant: from 5 to 8 for the primary dentition. The second digit indicates the tooth within a quadrant. For example: **85** indicated deciduous mand. Right 2nd molar.
